Job Creation Legislation Signed by Governor Doyle

Central Wisconsin will soon see 600 green manufacturing jobs

Madison-“A barrier to the immediate need for job creation has been eliminated, and the potential for 600 new jobs in central Wisconsin is now a reality thanks to Governor Doyle signing into law a bill passed just last week by the Assembly and the Senate. The new law waives certain limitations on federal bond allocations for shovel-ready projects seeking non-traditional financing,” said Rep. Louis J. Molepske, Jr., Chair of the Assembly Jobs, the Economy and Small Business Committee and Assembly sponsor of the bill.
